Jouke van Dijk (1956) is Professor of Regional Labour Market Analysis and chair of the Department of Economic Geography at the Faculty of Spatial Sciences of the University of Groningen. He also Board Member of the Wadden Academy, a research institute of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences, that sets the agenda and coordinates research activities in the field of Ecology, Geology, Economics and Social Sciences in the Wadden area. Van Dijk graduated in 1981 in Regional Science at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Groningen. In 1986 he obtained his doctoral degree on the thesis 'Migration and the Labour Market'. From 1981 till 1991 he hold several positions at the Department of Spatial Economics of the Faculty of Economics. Van Dijk teaches courses like Introduction in Micro- and Macro Economics, Regional Labour Market Analysis, Economic Geography and Migration partly in Dutch and in English. His research has a strong focus on labour market issues like unemployment, employment, the dynamics of regional labour markets and migration. Van Dijk is programme leader of the Economic Geography research programme "Explaining Spatial Economic Change" that focusses on regional labour market analysis and firm demography. The research in this programme over the period 2000-2006 was rated as one of the best in the Netherlands in the report "Assessment of Urban and Regional Research in the Netherlands, 2000-2006" by an international evaluation committee in 2007. He is currently President of the European Regional Science Association (ERSA).
