
Special Session (SS06) on: Cities and climate change

The purpose and scope of the special session

Cities are home to 57% of the world's population, responsible for over 70% of global consumption–related carbon emissions and contributing to over 80% of gross domestic product in many countries. Cities are pivotal players in the ongoing fight against climate change. This special session aims to explore the dynamic interplay between cities and climate change, offering a platform for scholarly exploration and practical insights. Contributions are welcome spanning sustainable urban development, climate resilience, and innovative solutions, fostering a cross-disciplinary dialogue. Key areas of focus will include:

- 1) greenhouse gas emissions accounting and database of cities;
