

The war in Ukraine resulted in the largest forced migration crisis in Europe since the Second World War. More than 6,2 Million people left Ukraine since February 2022 to seek safety abroad. Such migration influx has tangible effects across the region and shapes the policy processes of the affected countries.

IOM Hungary calls scholars to join this Special Session to nurture the discussion on the regional impacts of the war in Ukraine. Papers shall contribute to understanding the needs of refugees, their challenges, and the opportunities for refugees and host communities in the current situation.
